PM: Travel to Ahemdabad (Night Train/bus)

Mumbai is a city that on arrival can feel stifling dense and utterly overwhelming. This incredible melee however provides the observer, designer and students with a plethora of nuance and reference with which to study and work. It is also the contrasting elements of tranquility and chaos that exist in such close proximity that we aimed to encounter first hand and from which the students could gain the most.

From the civic heart of places like the Banganga water tank on Nariman Point we were able to form links and references between this tranquility and the courtyard houses of Studio Mumbai that take at their heart very similar notions of centrality and boundary.

The timber market in Central Mumbai where architect Samuel Barclay and his local trader gave us a detailed tour, was an important chance for the students to learn about the local timber trade, the market, species available and above all the methods of processing and working with timber, predominantly tropical hardwoods. This provided a valuable link to the houses that we had visited, the timber of which is largely sourced from the central market.
